

ABOUT TRIPURA

Tripura, a northeastern Indian state, is celebrated for its rich cultural heritage, diverse tribal communities, and scenic landscapes. Bordered by Bangladesh, Mizoram, and Assam, this land of hills and valleys is one of the famed "Seven Sister States" of India.

Once a princely state under the Manikya Dynasty for over 1300 years, Tripura became a Union Territory in 1956 and gained full statehood on January 21, 1972. It also holds untapped reserves of natural gas and runs on gas-based thermal power plants for most of its energy needs.

Tripura has produced many iconic personalities. Notably, the legendary music director S.D. Burman and his son R.D. Burman hailed from the royal family. Olympic gymnast Dipa Karmakar, the first Indian woman gymnast to compete at the Olympics (2016), is also from here.

The state capital, Agartala, is a blend of heritage and beauty. Ujjayanta Palace, built in 1901 by Maharaja Radhakishore Manikya in Indo-Greek style, is a must-visit. Nearby, the Heritage Park offers an educational and relaxing escape for locals and tourists alike.

Agartala also boasts the serene Venuban Vihar, a Buddhist shrine housing a Burmese idol of Lord Buddha, and the 19th-century Jagannath Temple, built by the Manikya dynasty on the lush grounds of the palace. Modern shopping areas and other temples are nestled throughout the town.

Just 55 km away lies the Tripura Sundari Temple (Matabari), one of the 51 revered Shakti Peethas, located in Udaipur. Another gem is Unakoti, an archaeological marvel known for its colossal rock-cut sculptures of Lord Shiva, located in Kailasahar, about 140 km from Agartala.

Nature lovers will be enchanted by Dumboor Lake, a sprawling 41 sq km lake with 48 islands, located 115 km from the capital. Equally unique is the Tripura Bamboo Park, the first of its kind in India, promoting eco-friendly bamboo-based innovation. It's situated 20 km west of Agartala in R.K. Nagar, near the Bodhjunnagar Industrial Growth Centre.

Tripura is full of hidden gems waiting to be explored—offering a perfect blend of culture, heritage, nature, and warmth.

Famous Landmarks Of Tripura



NEERMAHAL

Known as the "Lake Palace of Tripura," Neermahal is a majestic water palace built in the middle of Rudrasagar Lake. This blend of Hindu and Mughal architecture once served as the summer retreat of the Tripura royals.

UJJAYANTA PALACE

A grand Indo-Greek-style palace built in 1901 by Maharaja Radhakishore Manikya, Ujjayanta Palace now stands as a symbol of Tripura's royal heritage and houses a museum that showcases the rich culture and history of the state.



UNAKOTI

Carved into the hillside near Kailasahar, Unakoti is an ancient Shaivite pilgrimage site featuring massive rock-cut sculptures and stone images of deities—most notably Lord Shiva. Its name means "one less than a crore."



DUMBOOR LAKE

This enchanting 41 sq km lake is dotted with 48 emerald-green islands and known for its serene waters, migratory birds, and boating experiences. It's located about 115 km from Agartala, offering a peaceful retreat in nature.



MATABARI (TRIPURA SUNDARI TEMPLE)

One of the 51 Shakti Peethas, this revered temple is dedicated to Goddess Tripura Sundari. Set atop a small hill in Udaipur, it's a major pilgrimage site blending spiritual serenity with timeless architecture.
