EC, in its 4th meeting held at Kushabhau Thakre Hall, Bhopal on 28th January 2023, passed the following resolution for carrying out the amendment in the Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations for placing the same before GC for subsequent approval.

Accordingly, the resolution is being circulated to the GC members for their perusal.

ITEM-00: To carry amendment in the Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations

i. GC, in its 101st meeting, approved the increase in quota of women from exiting two to four out of the co-opted members. This has necessitated the following amendment in Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations of IBC:

ii. GC, in its 101st meeting, approved the Rules and Regulations for the State / Local Chapters of IBC. This has necessitated the following amendment in Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations of IBC:

A. Memorandum of Association

a. Replace Rule 3(u) by the following: -

3-u. To establish State Chapters in all states/Union Territories and Local Chapters in all Metropolitan /other cities to carry out and promote its above-stated activities.

b. Existing 3(u) may be read as 3(v) as under: -

3-v. To do such other lawful things as may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of excellence in built environment and buildings.

B. Rules and Regulations

Add the following para as para 4 in the Rules and Regulations: -

a. State Chapters

Indian Buildings Congress shall establish its State chapter in each state/ union territory of India. Such Chapters of Indian Buildings Congress are intended to be formed primarily for technical activities of the members of IBC residing within the geographical sphere of the Chapters. The Chapters so constituted are purported to provide forums to promote professional acumen and mutual personal contacts amongst members of the Chapters.

b. Local Chapters

IBC may also establish one or more local chapters within the geographical boundaries of a state provided the total strength of the life members residing or practicing or carrying on business within the geographical boundaries of the proposed Local Chapter is not less than twenty-five.

The existing para 4 shall be read as para 5 and all the succeeding sections stand re-numbered accordingly.
