
## **INDIAN BUILDINGS CONGRESS**

# The rights and privileges for Life Member, Ordinary member, Student member and Institutional Members

1. Free Periodicals to members against membership fee. Built Environment will be sent by ordinary post. Preliminary Publication and IBC journal is sent by courier/regd. Book-post. Members can have e-copies of these publications on request.

### (a) Built Environment (Bi-Monthly)

This is the Bi-monthly News magazine of the Indian Buildings Congress. The News items on creation of green and sustainable built environment, new technologies, news about any big or prestigious project, forth coming events of IBC and highlights of concluded events are prominent part of this periodical. Members of IBC can also send their views and articles of common interest on subjects connected with any aspect of Building Engineering for publishing in the magazine. All 6 issues published during the year are sent to all members, free of cost.



## (b) IBC Journal (Yearly)

IBC Journal is an annual publication of IBC which contains the papers/articles of eminent authors on a selected topic. The papers/articles in IBC Journal are of state-of-art innovations, policies of Government, futuristic concepts and other subjects related to the selected topic of the Built-Environment. Papers/Articles published in IBC Journal attract greater attention of all members, professionals and stake-holders in the industry for gaining additional knowledge, information, new ideas, etc. and is referred to as a reference book on the related topic. in construction of buildings and related infrastructure.



## (c) Preliminary Publication (Half Yearly)

This periodical is published half yearly by the Indian Buildings Congress during its Mid-term and Annual Sessions on a selected theme related to Built-Environment. The technical papers submitted by senior professionals/academicians and selected by a high-level technical committee for presentation by the authors in the Seminar held during the Mid Term and Annual Sessions, are published in this periodical. The Recommendations which emanate out of the deliberations of papers during the Seminar are also sent to Central Govt., State Governments, various Development Authorities, Housing Boards, Municipal Authorities and renowned builders for implementation.



### 2. REBATE ON PURCHASE OF IBC PUBLICATIONS

- a. discount of 25% is allowed for members i/c student members of IBC on purchase of one set of all publications of IBC.
- b. discount of 25% is allowed for Institutional members of IBC on any number of copies of all publications of IBC

#### 3. INVITATION FOR EVENTS

- The members of IBC will be invited in Annual Session of Indian Buildings Congress as well as National/International Seminars/webinars being organized by IBC from time to time. Participation in events organized by IBC is complimentary for Life Members of IBC.
  - o To attend the Annual General Meeting of IBC, membership is mandatory.

#### 4. CONTRIBUTIONS OF TECHNICAL PAPERS AND AWARDS FOR BEST PAPERS

- IBC provides a platform to its members by giving them opportunity to contribute Technical Papers for presenting during its technical Seminars/webinars. The papers presented in Midterm/Annual sessions are printed in the preliminary publication of IBC.
- IBC has also instituted Awards, Medals and Certificate for the best papers presented during the Mid-term/Annual sessions which are awarded by Chief Guest during Valedictory function of Annual Session.

## 5. OPPORTUNITY TO BECOME GOVERNING COUNCIL MEMBER (GOVERNING BODY OF IBC)

- During the Annual Session of IBC each year, the individual members of Indian Buildings Congress will be entitled to contest election for Governing Council Members as per relevant rules of MoA of IBC.

\*Student Members have no voting power.

## **5.1. Special benefit to Institutional Members:**

Institutional Members are entitled to nominate two free delegates to attend Annual Convention and Mid Term Session of IBC. In the elections for Governing Council, during Annual Session of IBC, representative of Institutional Members would be entitled to contest for a Council membership under the relevant rules of MoA of IBC.as reproduced below:

- (a) Two representatives from different State Housing Boards, two representatives from Development Authorities and one representative from public sector undertakings other than housing boards and development authorities who are Institutional Members of IBC and one representative from private sector organizations who are Institutional Member of IBC under Rule 9.1.3.1 to be elected by their representatives who are present at the Annual General Meeting.
- (b) One representative of Educational/Research Institutions, Universities, I.I.T.s, Engineering Colleges which are duly recognized and are Institutional Members of IBC under Rule 9.1.3.2 to be elected by their representatives who are present at the Annual General Meeting.
- (c) Two representatives from Zila Parishads /District Panchayats/District Boards who are Institutional Members of IBC under Rule 9.1.3.3 to be elected by their representatives who are present at the Annual General Meeting.
- (d) One representative from Rural/Urban Development Departments and one from Improvement Trust/Cantonment Boards/Municipal Bodies who are Institutional Members of IBC under Rule 9.1.3.4 to be elected by their representatives who are present at the Annual General Meeting.
- (e) Five representatives from (other than Builders Association of India and Builders Federation of India) other Builders Associations which are registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860 and which are Institutional Members of IBC under Rule 9.1.3.5 to be elected by their representatives who are present at the Annual General Meeting.

## 6. The Authors of published papers in IBC publications are entitled for following Awards/Medals:

- i. Sh. SP Jakhanwal Best Paper Award: One IBC medal and Citation of the Author is awarded annually for the best paper; being an original work of innovation and technical excellence, adjudged out of the papers published in IBC Journal /Preliminary Publication during the preceding one year. This award has been instituted in memory of Sh. SP Jakhanwal, Former VC, DDA, one of the Founding Organization of IBC.
- ii. IBC Best Paper Medal during IBC Seminar: Upto 3 medals may be awarded for 3 best papers, being of high quality and merit; presented during each of the Seminars held during Mid Term and Annual Sessions, as adjudged by the Committee constituted by the President. This medal is awarded to the awardees by the Chief Guest in the Valedictory function of the Annual Convention and Session.
- iii. Commendation Certificate: In addition to the three medals as stated above, upto 3 Commendation certificates may be awarded to the papers, being of a decidedly more than average quality and merit; presented during each of the Seminars held during Mid Term and Annual Sessions, as adjudged by the Committee constituted by the President. This medal is awarded to the awardees by the Chief Guest in the Valedictory function of the Annual Convention and Session.
- iv. Indian Buildings Congress Best Paper Award/ Medal for young Professional (below 35 years of age): Upto 3 medals may be awarded for 3 best papers, being of high quality and merit; authored and presented by the young professionals (below the age of 35 years of age) during each of the Seminars held during Mid Term and Annual Sessions, as adjudged by the Committee constituted by the President. One of the awardees shall be a lady professional, below 35 years of age. This medal is awarded to the awardees by the Chief Guest in the Valedictory function of the Annual Convention and Session.

#### 6.0 Other Awards:

- i. Smt. Satya Goel Memorial Award: This award, consisting of a Citation and a plaque is given to an outstanding woman building professional for contribution to the profession and remarkable achievements during the last three years. Nomination may be called from members of the IBC, other professional bodies, building departments of the Government of India and state Governments, Public Sector and Private bodies involved in built environment, etc. The professional may be selected by a committee constituted by the Executive Committee/President. The award consists of a Citation alongwith a Trophy or a plaque
- **ii. Outstanding Contribution to IBC Award:** This award consisting of a Citation, a Plaque and Shawl, is awarded to maximum 2 persons in a year who are IBC members, in recognition of the outstanding contribution made by them to the activities of IBC. The awardees are selected by the jury constituted by the President
- **iii. IBC President's Award:** This award is awarded to IBC members, whom the President feels have worked extensively in helping him discharge his duties as President of IBC. The selection of awardees for the President's Award is at the sole discretion of the President.

These awards are awarded by the Chief Guest during Inaugural function of Annual Session of IBC.
