Indian Buildings Congress (IBC) was founded on 1st September 1992 and registered as a Society on 29th March 1993, with its headquarter at New Delhi. The vision of the organization is a built environment, which is affordable, aesthetic, environment friendly, cost effective & competitive technology driven Built Environment capable of meeting needs of the Indian masses. In order to meet its objectives, IBC is striving continuously to bring all professionals connected with built environment on a single platform so as to form collective opinion on subjects related to Building Industry and present for consideration of the Government. Over 6500 Individual Members and over 112 Institutional Members, both in the Public and Private Sector, are members of IBC.

THE CONVENTION:

IBC will be holding its 27th Annual Convention & National Seminar at Manekshaw Centre, Dhaula Kuan, New Delhi on 13-14 July, 2024. The Annual Convention, apart from conducting business like holding of AGM, Governing Council Meetings and appointment of Office-Bearers for ensuing term, will also include a Seminar on "Challenges & Innovations in Urban Planning & Development". Members of the IBC and professionals of Government Departments, Housing Boards, Development Authorities, Town & Country Planning Organisations, State PWDs, Teaching & Training Institutes, Technical Universities, Builders, Developers and all others interested in building management are cordially invited to participate.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR:

India is one of the most rapidly urbanizing countries in the world. It is expected that half of the country's population would be living in urban areas in few decades. India has now become the most populous country in the world. Urbanization is a continuous process and almost impossible to reverse. People migrate from rural areas to urban areas in search of employment opportunities, better education & healthcare and a higher standard of living.

Although urbanization is considered as a healthy sign for any economy, unplanned urbanization leads to several issues. These issues include lack of proper infrastructure, unhygienic living conditions, extreme pressure on existing infrastructure, pollution and many more. Unplanned urbanization not only leads to a fall in the quality of life but also has consequences for the environment. Rising population, rapidly changing demography, rising resource and infrastructure deficit, slack urban governance and poor service delivery presents a set of complex urban challenges in India which reflect on basic urban amenities such as water, sanitation, sewage, road, transportation among others that must be addressed to ensure cities remain vibrant and functional. Major challenges requiring innovative approaches to address include - Rapid Urbanization; Infrastructure Development; Climate Change and Resilience; Affordable Housing;

Affordable Rental Housing; Traffic Congestion; Heritage Conservation; Informal Settlements; Digital Transformation; Waste Management and Financing of Urban Infrastructure & Services.

The main purpose of the seminar is to bring together all stakeholders connected with built environment including Researchers/Professionals/Administrators/Financiers / Planners, Developers / Architects / Engineers of all disciplines / Horticulturists / Builders / Teachers and Manufacturers of building materials & machinery on a single platform to discuss Challenges & Innovations in Urban Planning & Development. It is accordingly planned to deliberate on the subject.
