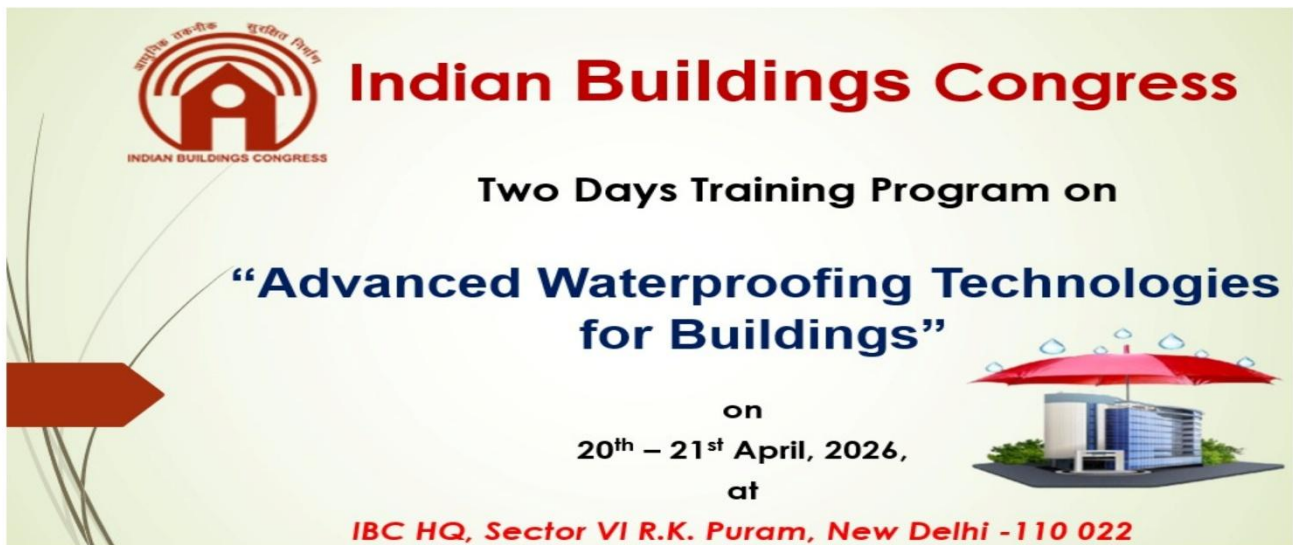


Report on Two-Day Training Program on “Advanced Waterproofing Technologies for Buildings”
